Hillside Contraband List

Children residing at Hillside are allowed to have in their possession specific personal items which do not impede the safety and security of all children and staff. All items that are donated to Hillside must adhere to this policy. The list below is an example of items that are considered contraband.

- Any item made from or including glass, with the exception of eyeglasses and nail polish
- Any items which contain metal or volatile parts (bras with underwire, spiral notebooks, etc.)
- Belts exceeding 2" wide and/or belt buckles exceeding 3" x 2"
- Cameras, tape recorders with external recording capacity
- Flammables
- Incense or candles
- Personal care items containing alcohol such as aerosol spray, mouthwash, perfume or similar preparations with alcohol content.
- Personal electronic games or battery operated games/toys
- Reading material that describes making of weapons, explosives, or other devices which may be used in an escape
- Toxic markers, Sharpies, or highlights
- Weapons (firearms, knives, or explosives)
